## How to make it happen:

- 1. Lay the outdoor mat in the garden.
- 2. Sing the song, "What's your name?". Include child's name in the song.
- 3. Seat one child on educarer's lap while one or two friends look on.
- 4. Use a scarf to hide the child on the lap from others.
- 5. Say, "Where is \_\_\_\_\_ (child's name)? Where is \_\_\_\_\_ (child's name)?"
- 6. Take the scarf away and look happily surprised.
- 7. Say, "Here's \_\_\_\_\_ (child's name)!"
- 8. Repeat the steps with another child on the lap.
- 9. Say, "Do you want to hide, \_\_\_\_ (child's name)?"
- 10. Repeat the song, "What's your name?" This time, educarer sings and gives the shaker to child A when child A's name is called.
- 11. Repeat the process until all children's names are called.
