• Children are able to count from 1 to 5

What children will experience (NEL Learning Areas):

Language and Literacy:

- Children will respond appropriately to instructions and questions
- Children will use language to describe their patterns

Numeracy:

• Children will be able to see and form a 2-object pattern

Social Emotional Development:

• Children will be able to support one another in the building of AB pattern

What you will need:

- Outdoor resources: flowers, pebbles, twigs, leaves, mats
- Writing materials



Suitable for:

4 years old

Benefit-Risk Assessment:

Benefit

- Children build logical thinking skills. Children are able to see a pattern and predict what comes after.
- Children also learn to share their learning with those who don't know.

Risk:

- Plants that are harmful.
- Ground may have debris or hazardous materials

Management:

• Be aware of those who are allergic to plants. To provide alternative material to children who have such allergy.

Check the ground is clear of debris or hazardous materials.

How to make it happen:

- 1. Introduce the word: 2-object pattern
- 2. Pick two outdoor materials, e.g., leaf, flower.
- 3. Form a set.
- 4. Repeat the set.
- 5. Read the set.
- 6. Engage children to predict the next set: e.g., leaf, flower, leaf, flower
 - Encourage children to form their own 2-objects pattern with their choice of outdoor materials.
 - For those who are not sure, they could observe their peers doing the activity first.
