<ul> <li>What you will need:</li> <li>Natural resources- pine cones, nuts shells, wooden sticks/twigs, pebbles, chalks and seeds</li> <li>Wooden and plastic materials: bottle caps, tubes, wooden beads, pegs, fabric, lids from jars or large bottles</li> <li>Shiny objects: metal and aluminium utensils, plastic mirrors, foil, shiny beads and ribbons or tapes</li> </ul>	Benefit-Risk Assessment:  Benefit:  Children can use a variety of loose parts that is provided  Connect with nature  Risk:  Ensure materials provided are non-choking, not sharp.

## Management:

- Scan the venue to ensure it is free from potential hazards such as sharp objects, pot holes, broken tiles or insects
- Set limits/boundary for children to explore
- Ensure teachers have sight of the children at all times
- Display a signage of the activity to inform public

## How to make it happen:

- 1. Take children out for a walk with the play crates as suggested above
- 2. Place crates and mats for children to sit and allow ample time to explore the materials in the crates
- 3. Facilitate children's exploration and discovery by asking questions and observing their play

## Questions to ask:

- What can you do with this material?
- What is the texture of the object?
- What would you like to make using this material/s?
