CARE AND LEARN Workshop

This learning workshop is for parents, grandparents, babysitters and maids, who want to learn more about caring for young children at home.

Duration: 6 hours

Topics:

FAMILY DAY CARE Course

This is a specialised course developed to equip professional home-based caregivers with the required skills and knowledge on how to plan and provide for the developmental needs of the young child in a home setting.

Duration: 30 hours

(comprising classroom sessions and community visits)

Content:

1. The Role of the Caregiver
2. Importance of Safety, Health and Nutrition
3. Planning the day for the child
4. How to manage children
5. Appropriate guidance and discipline
6. Caregiver & Child Relationships

Course fee: \$300 (before 50% subsidy from the Ministry of Community Development, Youth and Sports)

** participants are required to attain 100% attendance to be eligible for the subsidy.*
