Kindergarten Fee Assistance Scheme (KiFAS)

To help keep the programme affordable and accessible for Singapore Citizen children



Who is eligible?

- Child is a Singapore Citizen and enrolled in an Anchor Operator (AOP) or Ministry of Education (MOE) kindergarten.
- Family's gross monthly household income is \$12,000° and below, or per capita income is \$3,000* and below for larger families.
- A Before CPF deduction and include bonuses, commissions, overtime pay and allowances.
- * 5 or more family members living in the same household (applicant's spouse will be included by default regardless of residential address) with at least 3 dependants who are not earning an income.



How much can I receive?



- KiFAS subsidy is means-tested
 - > Ranges from \$17 to \$161.
 - > Lower-income families will receive more assistance.



The subsidy will be directly disbursed to your child's kindergarten and you pay only net fee which can come from your Child Development Account.

What is Special Approval for KiFAS?

Applicants in the following groups may apply for higher subsidy support under Special Approval:



Non-parent caregivers who are caring for the child such as grandparents, legal guardian, foster parents and children's home.



Children under HDB's Public Rental Scheme or ComCare Short-To-Medium-Term Assistance (SMTA) or Long-Term Assistance (LTA) will automatically qualify for maximum preschool subsidies upon application for Special Approval.



When will my subsidy eligibility be assessed/re-assessed?

- When your child enrols at a new kindergarten.
- When child promotes from Nursery 2 (N2) to Kindergarten 1 (K1) i.e. at the end of N2.

Subsidy will remain unchanged between fixed points of subsidy assessment.

ECDA will notify you before the re-assessment of your household/per capita income is done, and update you of the outcome.

How do I apply?

- Complete the KiFAS Application Form (i.e. KF1) with the relevant supporting documents and submit it to ECDA through your child's kindergarten.
- Remember to give your telephone numbers and email address.
- ECDA will send you an SMS and email to acknowledge your application and its outcome.





What else do I need to note?

 Your child needs to attend preschool for at least one day in a month to receive the subsidy for that month.

KiFAS Start-Up Grant (SUG)

Yearly grant covering intitial costs

e.g. registration fee, deposit, school uniform, insurance, educational material fees etc.



Who is eligible?

- Singapore Citizen child.
- Families with monthly gross income of up to \$1,900 or gross per capita income of up to \$650.

How much can I receive?

- Each application will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
- Capped at \$240 per year.

How do I apply?

 Fill in the KiFAS Application Form (i.e. KF1) with the relevant supporting documents and submit it to ECDA through your child's kindergarten.
